Provides Primary Medical Care, dental extractions, vision exams and a Neurology specialty clinic.

Eligibility:

Must be a resident of North Charleston or Hanahan. Must be between the ages of 18-65. Must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL – see chart) for your household. Must bring a valid photo ID, proof of residency (phone, utility bill, etc.) and one of the following: 1099, 2 recent pay stubs, tax return or food stamp letter.

Services:

Provides primary care or routine physicals, pediatrics, gynecological or family planning, dental, surgical needs other than minor surgery, imaging studies such as MRI or CT scans

Eligibility:

No insurance, including Medicare, Medicaid or veterans benefits. Household income of less than 200% of the federal poverty level (see chart). Place of residency does NOT affect eligibility. Patient eligible for care are also eligible to receive medications from our pharmacy as well as lab testing and supplies.
